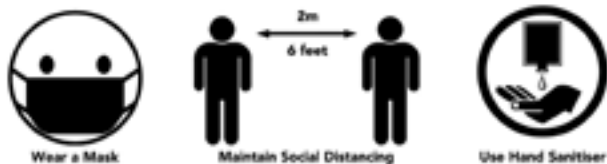
This Week's Lenten Prayer - A Prayer for Healthcare Workers
