Watch over the children of Ireland,

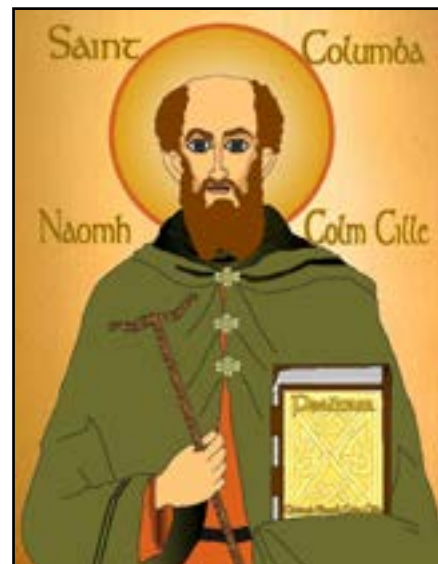
Scattered throughout the world.

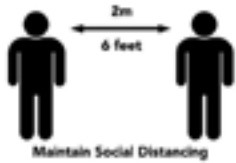
