Due to the fact that large outdoor gatherings are unlikely to be permitted again this summer, it will not be possible to hold the annual Graveyard Mass as normal this year. I will instead do a short unannounced service and blessing of the graves and offer up a Sunday Mass in the Church for all who are buried in the graveyards of the parish. However, if circumstances change and it is considered safe for large crowds to gather outdoors, we may hold a Mass or service later in the year.

Rosary will conclude on Monday evening. Thanks to all those who helped lead the Rosary every evening during the month of May.

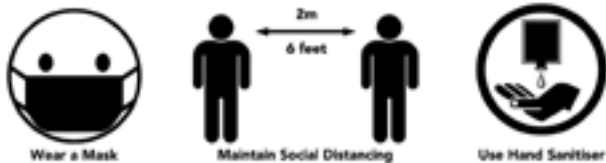
ATTENDING THE CHURCH FOR MASS

If you would like to attend a Mass in N. Fionán, **please consider going to one of the weekday Masses instead of a weekend Mass.** There is more availability of space at weekday Masses, than at weekends. Under the current guidelines, once the church has reached its capacity for a Mass, the doors will be closed, and people will be asked to either go to Aras Begley to listen (20 seats available) or return to their car to listen instead. So please consider a weekday Mass if you wish to attend. Thank you. With social distancing, our church here can accommodate roughly 110-118 – two areas/zones in the main church with up to 50 people in each and an additional 18 people in the day chapel. **Please also remember There is no obligation on anyone to attend Mass at the present.**

Mass will continue to be broadcast on our parish webcam and parish radio. You can join in with the Mass from your home.

Funerals and Weddings: The number of people allowed to attend weddings and funerals will also increase to 50 from the 10th May. While churches may be able to safely hold more with different zones, 50 is the maximum number of people allowed to attend a wedding or funeral.
