I was tired and sleeping on my idle bed

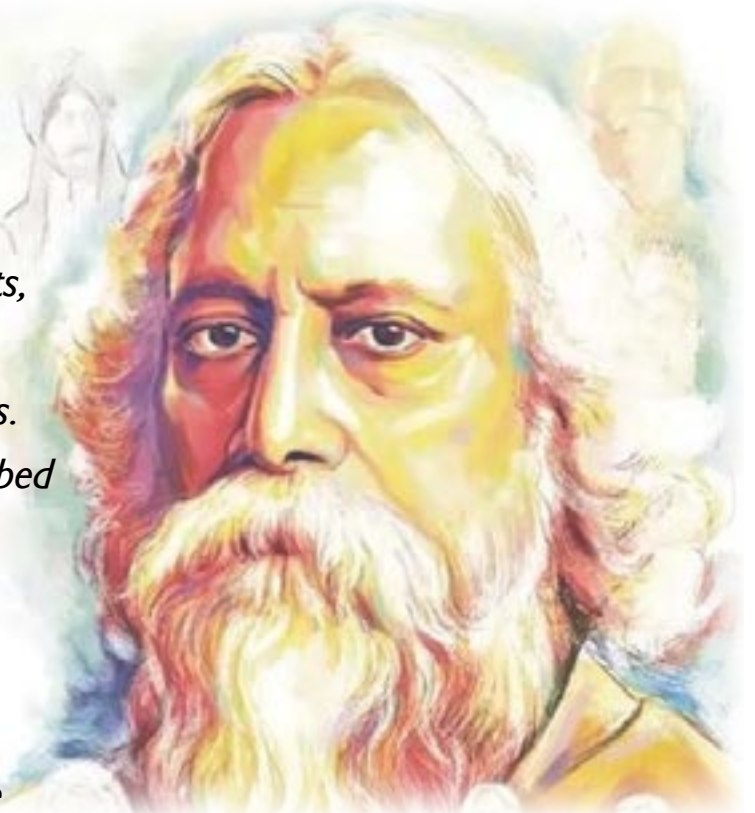
and imagining all work had ceased.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

Eucharistic Adoration commenced again in our Parish Church on Thursday 10th June: commencing immediately after 10am Mass through to 9pm. It will conclude with the rosary at 8.30pm. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be recited at 5.30pm.

As of now we have just the minimum number of two people for each hour; however, a minimum of four adorers per hour would be more desirable. We need more people to commit to Eucharistic Adoration and we would ask you to consider this. Time sheets are available in the church porches so please take one and return to the church. Sheets can be placed in the same boxes as the weekend church envelope.

Those who cannot commit to a specific hour may wish to have their names placed on a FLOATER LIST. This list would comprise of the names of people willing to be called upon to cover for individuals who cannot fulfil their commitment on a particular Thursday. The individuals who avail of this option are a valuable addition to the success of Eucharist Adoration.

The invitation to Eucharistic Adoration is there for all of us and even a short visit to the Church at any time on a Thursday is encouraged for everyone.
