Discovering One's Own Riches

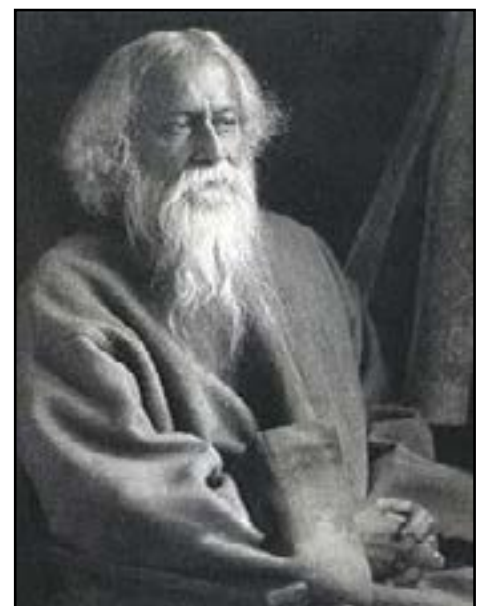
*I lived on the shady side of the road
