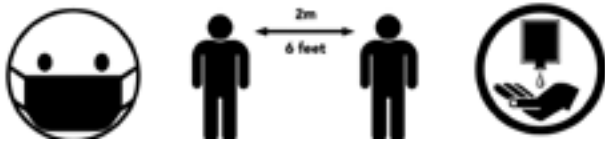

ATTENDING THE CHURCH FOR MASS FROM 6TH SEPTEMBER.

As a result of the new government Covid -19 guidelines, churches can now have up to 50% capacity for religious ceremonies from tomorrow, 6th September. Weddings remain at their current limit of 100 persons for now. All other current restrictions continue to apply.

Points to remember when visiting the church for Mass or for private prayer.

(Use wipes provided and ensure your hands are dry from the sanitiser before lighting candles)



Please follow the guidelines on social distancing, etc., when attending the church for Mass. As it is in all other public building at this time - Please wear a face mask in the church when attending and during Mass, religious service or visiting the church & sanitise your hands on entering and leaving the building. It is VERY IMPORTANT to also remember and remain safe at home:

- If your health is vulnerable or you feel unsure about coming out
- If you have Covid-19 or have had contact with someone who has
- If you are awaiting results of a Covid-19 test
- If you have a flu or cold like symptoms
