Today we take light for granted. Hard as it to believe, there was a time when there was no electricity and immediate light at the touch of a button was unheard of. Even for those who could afford candles or an oil lamp, the light they gave off was poor and limited. This was the world in which Jesus lived.

In the gospel this Sunday, Jesus uses light, a very common thing to describe the quality needed to be his follower and disciple. The words he uses are as equally challenging as they encouraging. In the Gospel of John there is a constant battle between light and darkness. Nicodemus, the Pharisee, visits Jesus at night, Jesus heals a man born into a world of darkness because he is blind, and when Judas leaves the table during the last supper, we are told that it was night. Yet it is into this darkness that Jesus comes with the good news. Also in John's gospel, Jesus proclaims these words of hope and encouragement, 'I am the light of the world; anyone who follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life'.
